Approaches to Parenting

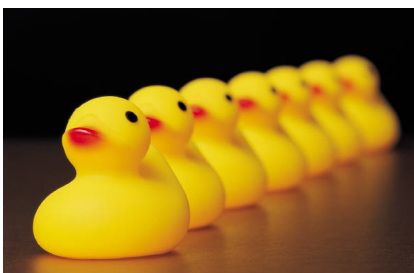
