



California State/University of California "A-G" Requirements

Area	Subject	Years of Study
A History	<p><u>Two units (equivalent to two years or four semesters) of history / social science required, including:</u> One year of world history, cultures and historical geography, and One year of U.S. history, or one-half year of U.S history and one-half year of civics or American government.</p>	
B English	<p><u>Four units (equivalent to four years or eight semesters) of college-preparatory English composition and literature required, integrating:</u> Extensive <i>reading</i> of classic and modern literature and content-rich works of non-fiction, Frequent <i>writing</i>, from brainstorming to final paper, and Practice <i>listening</i> and <i>speaking</i> with different audiences.</p>	
C Mathematics	<p><u>Three units (equivalent to three years or six semesters) of college-preparatory mathematics are required (four units are strongly recommended) including or integrating topics covered in:</u> Elementary algebra Advanced algebra Two- and three-dimensional geometry Also acceptable are courses that address the above content areas, and include or integrate: Trigonometry & Statistics</p>	
D Science	<p><u>Two units (equivalent to two years or four semesters) of laboratory science are required (three units are strongly recommended), providing fundamental knowledge in two of the following disciplines:</u> Biology Chemistry Physics</p>	
E Language Other Than English	<p><u>Two units (equivalent to two years or four semesters, or through the second level of high school instruction) of the same language other than English (three units recommended) including:</u> Emphasis on <i>speaking</i> and <i>understanding</i> Development of <i>awareness</i> and <i>understanding</i> of the <i>cultural context</i> around the target language Practice with <i>reading</i> and <i>composition</i> Instruction on <i>grammar</i> and <i>vocabulary</i></p>	
F VAPA	<p><u>One unit (equivalent to one year or two semesters) required, chosen from one of the following disciplines:</u> Dance Music Theater Visual arts (e.g., painting, web/graphic design, film/video, inter/multimedia arts)</p>	
G Elective	<p><u>One unit (equivalent to one year or two semesters) of college-preparatory coursework is required. Courses must be:</u> One year (two semesters) of a course approved specifically in the "g" subject area, including courses that combine any of the "a-f" subject areas in an interdisciplinary fashion; or One year (two semesters) of an additional approved "a-f" course beyond the minimum required for that subject area.</p>
