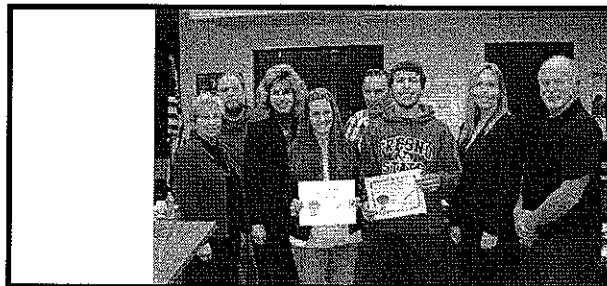

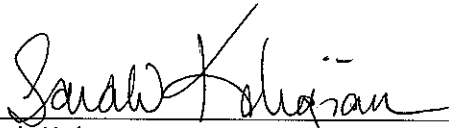
The Board agreed to have Superintendent Koligian mail a letter of support in lieu an Agreement with Yosemite Unified School District.
