The Aiea High School Dress Standard was developed to ensure that students dress appropriately for the school setting. The following guidelines have been adopted by the Aiea High School, School Community Council.

**Guidelines are as follows:**

**Appropriate Attire:**

- Students are required to have their ID's in their possession at all times. They are not required to wear their ID's.
- Uniform T-Shirt that has been approved by administration. No Altering of T-Shirt in any way, which includes tying or cutting, will be allowed.
- Pants, capris, overalls, shorts, skirts must be of appropriate length. (Note: see inappropriate attire)
- Footwear: Shoes, sandals, or slippers must be worn.
- Students' attire for assemblies and/or activities is subject to the discretion of the advisor or coach

**Inappropriate Attire:**

- Attire which promotes drugs, gangs or gang activity, sexploitation, discrimination (racial, religious, etc.) profanity or violence.
- No Bandanas
- Clothing that exposes underwear. Examples: Low ride pants that expose the top of the underpants, pants that are inappropriately worn, exposing underwear.
- Clothing that reveals the wearer's midriff, cleavage or breasts, navel or buttocks.
- Sleeveless undershirts or oversized tank tops
- Sunglasses, hats, visors, beanies may not be worn in classrooms or during class time. Exceptions will be allowed for medical reasons.

**Consequences for Violating Dress Standards:**

- Student may be sent home to change into appropriate attire. (All attempts will be made to notify parent/guardian when child is being sent home)
- Administration may impose further consequences for repeated offenses, such as Saturday School.

**Please note:** every attempt will be made to contact you if your child will be sent home due to a Dress Standard Violation. If for whatever reason we cannot contact you, Administration reserves the right to send your child home without receiving parent / guardian approval to change into appropriate attire.
