The meeting started at 3:50 with Officer Wardel Cox. He was in attendance to introduce himself as the new school resource officer for Canton ISD. Mr. Tullos explained that he started the hiring process a year and a half ago to have a resource officer for the district to deter possible problems from happening on campus. Officer Cox gave his background and explained his many duties here in the district, and that the district has applied to be a police force commission so that he may write citations and work more independently instead of having to go through Canton Police Department.

Nurse Jennifer Moore explained that right now, there are many things going on in the district to ensure safety and health of our kids this time of year with flu season around the corner. Each campus has stressed good hand hygiene and health education and worked with teachers and staff members to ensure that everyone is washing their hands the correct way. The district hosted a flu shot clinic Oct 14th and estimated about 250 shots were given in order to prevent the flu. Campus staff will continue to send sick students to clinic to be evaluated to determine whether or not that student should be sent home. Mr. Tullos and Nurse Moore spoke about how the district is implementing updated Ebola Surveillance and screening according to the CDC guidelines. Nurse Moore spoke about how the custodial staff is working daily to ensure sanitation of high trafficked areas such as tables, door knobs, toilets, sinks, water fountains, etc., with approved Virex cleaning solution.
