# Overview: District facility program

- Measure C 1998 \$95 million
- Measure G 2006 \$ 90 million
- State grants 1999-2006
  - Facility modernization
  - \$35 million
- State funding approved 1999-2006
  - Approx. \$25 million
  - For modernization and CTE
  - Three CTE projects will be launched in Spring/Summer 2016
  - Requires district match 50%





# Overview: Facility needs

- Average age of district schools
  - 50+ years
- Old, traditional design
  - Single level, "range" style
  - Classroom wings
  - Small spaces
  - Not flexible
  - Based on traditional education model
- Facility needs analysis
  - Comprehensive analysis is being performed
  - Identified need is over \$300 million

# Polling / Surveys / Input

### District engaged in a comprehensive input and survey process:

- Public engagement mail (over 600 responses)
- Online engagement email (over 150 responses)
- Site meetings with Teachers / staff
- PTSAs
- Boosters
- Voter survey / poll (500 likely voters surveyed)
- Community meetings
- Meetings with feeder districts
- Workshops and updates to Board of Trustees
- Incorporating input and feedback into bond projects and strategy

#### Common theme in polling and surveys:


Provide our students the facilities, instruction, and opportunities necessary to succeed in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Silicon Valley
