HEALTHY START:

- Ensure that each child receives the physical, emotional, and intellectual support that he or she needs-in school, at home, and in the community-to learn well.
- Build the capacity of students and parents to be participants, leaders, and decision-makers in their communities.
- Help schools and other child and family-serving agencies to recognize, streamline and integrate their programs to provide more effective support to children and their families.

COLLEGE CORNER:

- **PSAT/NMSQT**, a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT and gives students a chance to qualify for scholarships given by National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), measures math, critical reading, and writing skills like the SAT.
- The **PSAT** contains questions from actual SAT and is designed to be slightly easier than the SAT. The SAT is used for college admission; **PSAT** scores are not sent to colleges.
- Upward Bound is an intensive pre-college preparatory program

WASC:

- The mission of the Commission is to foster excellence by encouraging school improvement through a process of continuing evaluation and to recognize, by accreditation, schools that meet an acceptable level of quality, in accordance with established criteria.

TITLE ONE:

- **Title I**, Part A provides supplemental federal funds to help meet the educational needs of low-achieving students in the highest-poverty schools.
- In order to access **Title I** funds, LAUSD schools must have a poverty threshold of at least 50% based on free- or reduced-price meal applications and/or *CalWORKS*.
- Schools that rank into **Title I** deliver supplemental services through a targeted assistance (TAS) program or **develop a comprehensive school-wide plan under the schoolwide program (SWP) model.**
