

Homeless Education: Dissemination of Public Notice of Rights for Homeless Children and Youth

42 U.S.C. 11432(g)(6)(A) states that each local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youth, shall ensure that:

(v) Public notice of the educational rights of homeless children and youth is disseminated where such children and youth receive services under this Act, such as:

- Schools
- Family shelters
- Soup kitchens
