PARENT OR GUARDIAN:

This letter serves as notification that Wink Elementary has been identified as a school under the Public Education Grant (PEG) Program for the 2017-2018 school year. This designation is due to the fact that the campus passing rate in STAAR *Writing* was 50% or lower for the tested grade (4th grade) in any two of the preceding three years in 2013, 2014 or 2015 school year.

Under the PEG criteria, a parent or guardian of a student can apply for either an interdistrict transfer provision or an intradistrict transfer provision, if appropriate for the school district.

The interdistrict transfer provision gives the parent or guardian of a student enrolled in the campus designated a PEG to apply to attend a campus in any other school district for the 2017-2018 school year. A school district chosen by the a student's parent under this statute is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in that district but may not use criteria that discriminates on the basis of a student's race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status. Alternatively, a district may accept interdistrict transfers under Section 25.036 of the *Texas Education Code*.

Under the PEG intradistrict transfer provision, a parent or guardian of a student in a PEG identified campus may apply to attend another campus in the same school district for the 2017-2018 school year. **The intradistrict provision is not an option for Wink Elementary.**
