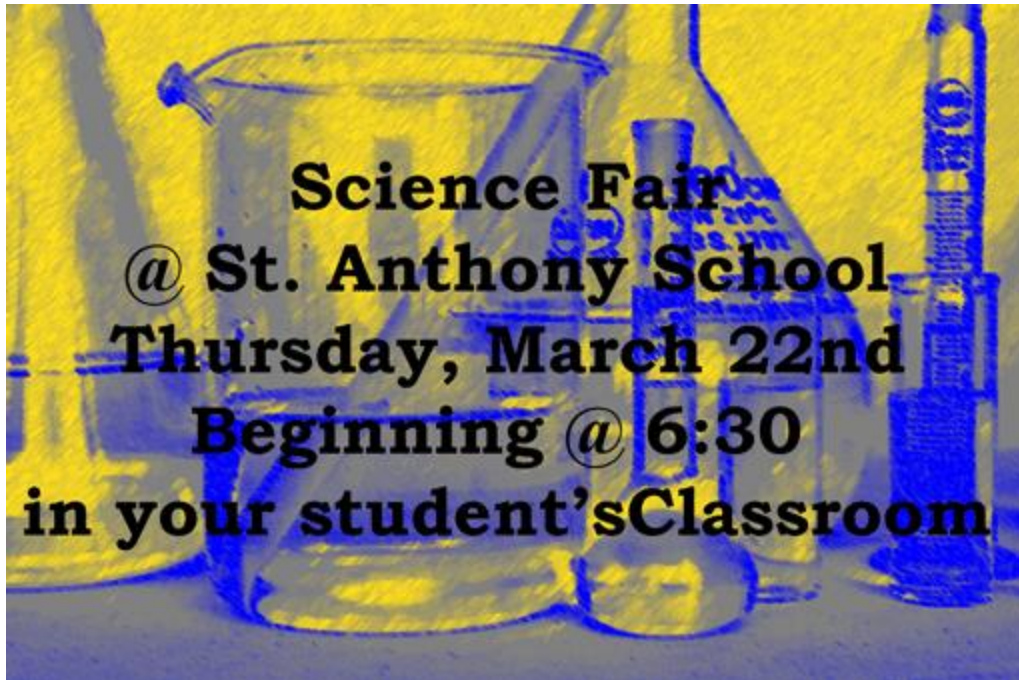

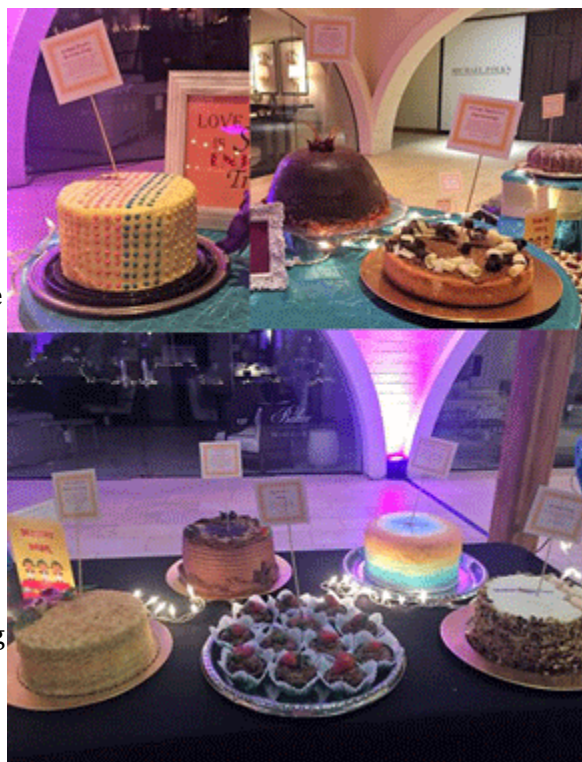

Make sure you're following us correctly on Facebook

In January, Facebook changed its news feed algorithm to limit the amount of business posting you receive in your news feed. While I'm sure we can all applaud this, St. Anthony School is considered a business and thus many of our posts are not reaching your news feeds (or being pushed to the bottom). To continue to see our posts, there is one change you need to make.

1. Make sure you are logged into Facebook.

3. At the top, directly under our cover picture, click on the word Following and check "See First."

We Act Penny Drive in 1 weeks

We Act will be holding a Penny Drive the week of March 19th - 23rd. All proceeds will go to our sister school in Haiti.

The Penny Drive, if successful, will be an annual event.

It is simple, fun and competitive.

Each grade level (not individual classes) will work together to be the grade with the highest points at the end of the week. Points can be accumulated by bringing in change.

However, only pennies count for positive points. Nickels, dimes and quarters count as negative points and subtract points from other grades.

This is how it works: students will want to bring in pennies for their own grade's jar to increase their points and bring in nickels, dimes and quarters to put into other grade's jars to drop their points. Each day, class totals will be published so classes can be strategic in how they use their silver coins.

The grade level with the most points at the end of the week will win a prize for the entire grade.

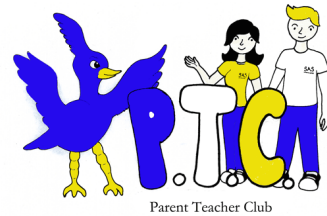

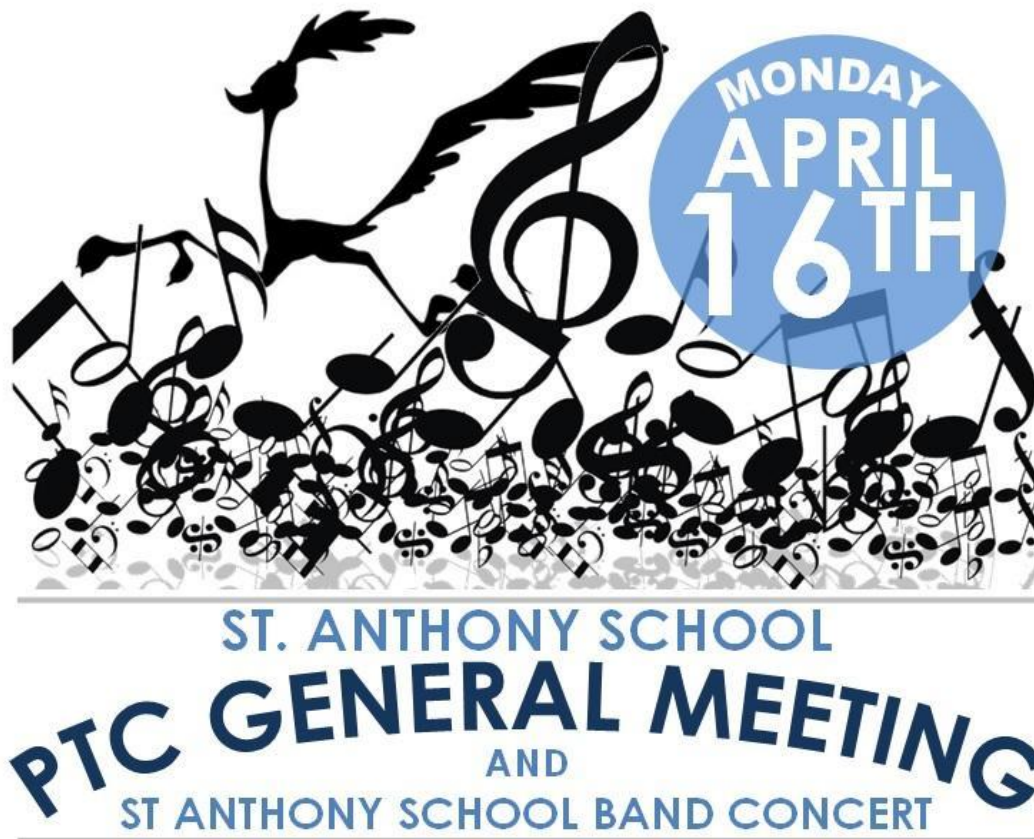

We are now accepting registrations for the St. Anthony Track & Field Team. Track and field is open to students in 4th-8th grades.

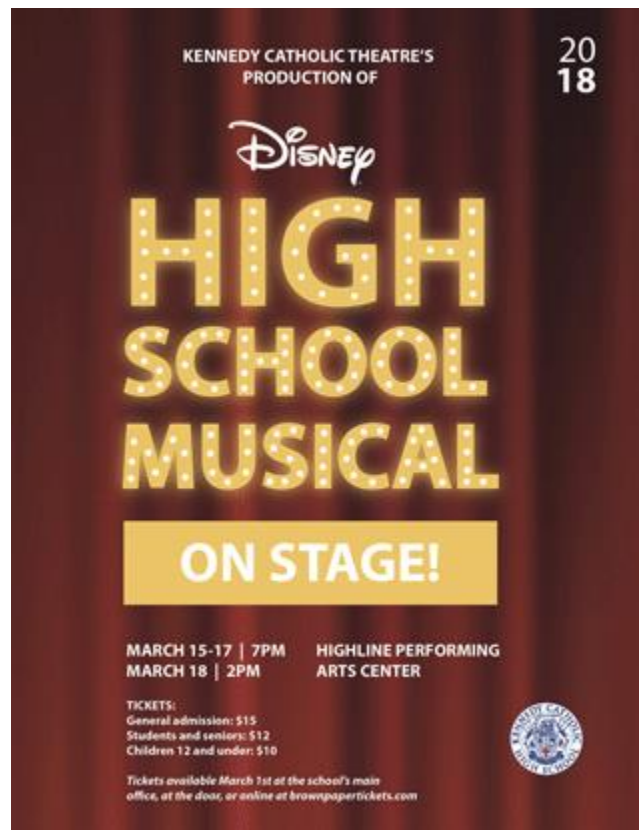
Practices will be at Lindbergh High School on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday at 6:00-7:30, beginning in mid-April.
