

What Does Each Priority Area Mean?

1. Base Services:

- Student access to standards-aligned textbooks
- Condition of school building

2. Common Core:

- Instruction based on the Common Core State Standards, including for English learners

3. Parental Involvement:

- Efforts to include parents and guardians in schools and in decision-making

4. Pupil Achievement:

- Student scores on standardized tests, number that are college ready, English proficient, etc.

5. Pupil Engagement:

- School attendance and absences
- Drop out rates in middle and high school

6. School Climate:

- Suspension and expulsion rates
- Other local measures

7. Course Access:

- Classes offered in all required subjects

8. Pupil Outcomes:

- Measures of student performance not included in the *Student Achievement* category
