### The Hill Kindness Project

The Hill PTO is excited to announce the Hill Kindness Project. Between April 24 and May 6, Hill students and their families will get to participate in a one-of-a-kind project that is designed to generate acts of kindness that families will be proud to partake in.

We are hoping to use the Hill Kindness Project not only as an opportunity to work together to spread kindness through our community, but also as an effort to raise the remaining money needed to install two gaga pits on our playground, along with funding for some additional items in our budget that are not paid for yet (field day, Husky Dads projects and money toward major purchases that have not been funded yet). We are hoping to raise at least \$3000 through the Hill Kindness Project.

We have chosen to partner with Raise Craze, a fundraising company with a goal of bringing kindness awareness to schools and neighborhoods.

We understand families are busy and asking you to add one more thing to your plates may seem like an overload, especially with the end of the year fast approaching. This is why we are using Raise Craze. Their website will do 90% of the fundraising and promotion work for us. Parents would just need to register their children on the website. You can also enter your friends' and family's email addresses if you wish to share our Kindness Project goals. Raise Craze will not sell any information we provide to third parties. On the site you will select from a pre-populated idea list of acts of kindness—or you can create your own. Raise Craze will then send out an email to your selected family/friends. For example, it would say:

(Nana, Mr. Smith, Johnny), I need your help!
I am participating in a unique fundraiser for the Hill Elementary Kindness Project. As a way of thanking my donors, I will be paying it forward by helping my community. Learn how I am giving back and how you can support me! \*\*Link to child's personal webpage\*\*

The link will bring the supporter to your child's personal Raise Craze page, where they can see which items your child has chosen for their acts of kindness. There are also options to spread the word through social media, if you would like to go that route, as well.

We hope that all families will participate in special acts of kindness this week, even if some can't participate on the fundraising side. We do not wish to burden families. Like the Jog-A-Thon, we recognize that not all families are able to donate money at this time, but everyone CAN find ways to pay it forward in our community. Remember, the most important thing here is to raise kindness awareness and have fun doing so. We will be doing a raffle of prizes (books about spreading kindness and making a difference) for students that raise any amount of money (even if it is \$1).

We would like to plan a group activity where we can come together as a class, or even better, as the entire school. Some ideas we have: writing letters to our soldiers, making cards for children in the hospital, or making shoe box toys for animal shelters. We welcome your ideas, so please don't be shy!

We will continue to bring you more details regarding the Hill Kindness Project as it gets closer to the kick-off date of April 23.
