- C. **Implementation.** Ensures that the LWP is implemented as intended including, but not limited to, communication/outreach that promotes information sharing and stakeholder engagement in developing, implementing, assessing, and updating the LWP
- D. **Records Retention.** Ensures that all documentation related to the LWP, implementation plan, and activities and/or events are retained as required
- E. **Update.** Ensures the LWP is evaluated each year to determine if changes are needed and ensures action is taken on needed changes
- F. **Other:**
