

FLORENCE SCHOOL DISTRICT TWO TITLE ONE PROGRAM FACTS

- Federal grant to meet the Special Educational Needs of the Educationally Deprived Children under Title I of Public Law 107-11.
- Title 1 targets resources to districts and schools where the needs are great in high poverty areas. Approximately 76.4% of the enrollment at HPEMS are considered children from low income families.
- The additional instruction and other strategies funded by the Title 1 program are intended to help insure that all children have the opportunity to obtain a quality education and achieve proficiency on all state assessments.
- Florence Two operates a school-wide program.
- Title II, a grant to prepare, train and recruit highly qualified teachers, provides funds in the amount of \$46,034.00 that is consolidated into the Title I School – wide program.
- Our school wide plan includes a comprehensive needs assessment, professional development, evaluation, reform strategies and a description of how the funds will be utilized.
- Title I funds are used to provide salaries, professional development opportunities and supports “The Leader In Me.”
- Hannah-Pamplico Elementary/Middle School is the only Title I School in Florence School District Two.
