Hello Parents and Guardians of AMS Students,

The AMS Administration - Mr. Brace and I - are working hard to ensure AMS remains safe and our students respectful and kind. We want to review some important rules and consequences currently in place.

The following rules apply to students:

1 – **Cell Phone and Electronic Device Use** – Cell phones and electronic devices and accessories are not allowed to be out on the school campus. They are to be in the student’s backpack. In the event that your child chooses to use or get their phone out there will be a series of consequences, beginning with losing their phone for the remainder of the day and detention to requiring the parent/guardian to pick it up at the end of the day, Saturday School and even suspension if it’s a chronic problem. If you need to reach your child during the day, please call the office and we can send them a message. I have told students that “texting your mom” is not a valid excuse for breaking this rule and consequences will follow.

2 – **No outside beverages will be allowed on campus** - Trash cans will be placed at the entrances to the campus so students can discard of their Dutch Bros., Starbucks, McDonalds, and any other outside containers at that time. Also, please note - any student that comes to school late and is bringing an outside beverage will not be allowed to go to class with that beverage.

3 – **Hats, beanies, hoods, visors, caps, and/or bandanas are not allowed** to be worn on campus. This is not a new rule but students need to be reminded. Baseball and softball hats will be allowed after school for practices and games.

4 – **Dress code** – Should your child choose to come to school wearing inappropriate clothing, as described below, appropriate clothing will be given to them in exchange for their inappropriate clothing and re-exchanged at the end of the day with discipline consequences from campus beautification to Saturday School.

PLEASE, do NOT bring in clothing if they call – we will provide clothing and encouragement/counseling to not repeat the same dress code offense(s).

- Clothing must be sufficient to cover undergarments at all times (not only when pulled on). See through fabrics, halter tops, off the shoulder, low cut, bare midriff and skirts, dresses or shorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited.
- Clothing bearing reference to or images of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, profanity or statements or picture that are inflammatory, suggestive or could be offensive to others are not allowed.
- No pajamas or blankets are allowed.
