3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress. Specifically, the School will provide reports as follows:

 - Communicate failing grades directly to parents no less than twice per nine weeks.

 - 7th grade teachers' planning 9:35-10:20
 - 6th grade teachers' planning 12:10-12:55
 - Other teacher's planning 1:35-2:20
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:
- serve as a representative on school improvement and advisory committees
 - help with art activities
 - assisting with special events
 - visit classrooms during specially scheduled parent observation days
