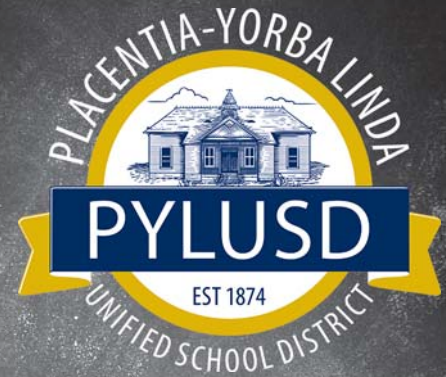


# BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

## Notes from the **Tuesday, March 14, 2017** PYLUSD Board of Education Meeting



### Board Actions

#### Board Policies – adopt, delete, review and revise

Second readings to adopt five Board Policies (BP) were presented: 1312.3, "Uniform Complaint Procedure"; 5145.3, "Nondiscrimination/Harassment"; 5145.7, "Sexual Harassment of Students"; 6121, "High School Athletics"; and 6142.7, "Physical Education and Activity." A second reading to delete one BP was also presented: 5145.31, "Civil and Legal Rights/Sex Discrimination (Title IX)." Additionally, one BP was reviewed: 6145, "Extra and Co-curricular Activities." Finally, first readings of three revised BPs were presented: 6145.5, "Student Clubs and Organizations"; 6180, "Evaluation of the Instructional Program"; and 6164.2, "Counseling and Guidance." The Board took action to move forward with all BPs.

#### 1. New property and liability insurance carrier

The Board adopted a resolution to approve an agreement with Southern California ReLiEF as the district's new property and liability insurance carrier effective July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2019. This company was selected after a Request for Proposals (RFP) process yielded four responses, which were reviewed by staff.

Assistant Superintendent of Business Services David Giordano provided an overview of the district's financial health. The Board approved the Report with a positive certification, indicating that PYLUSD will meet its financial obligations.

#### Coast to Coast Foundation receives "Advantage" award
