

NEW KINDERGARTEN AND NEW FIRST GRADE STUDENTS

According to State law, a child who has reached five years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year is eligible to attend kindergarten. Children enrolling in first grade must also be six years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year. A student who is five years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year and has completed public school kindergarten in another state or is enrolled in public school first grade class in another state may continue in the first grade if he/she moves into the Crystal City ISD during the school year. An underage transfer student previously attending a public school in another state who is the child of custodial parent who is active member of the US Military that has been stationed on active duty may continue kindergarten, provided the parent is a member of the Military Interstate Compact from the previous state.
