Fees: \$8.00 School Fee (pays for student planner, student ID, and locker fee). This fee MUST be paid when students pick up schedules in the summer. Students will not receive a schedule until this fee is paid.

Schedule Pick-Up: Seniors: July 31st 9:00-11:00, Juniors: July 31st 12:00-2:00, Sophomores: August 1st 9:00-11:00, Make-Ups: August 1st 12:00-2:00, Freshmen: August 4th, (**Freshman Orientation 8:00-12:00**) schedule pick up after orientation, 12:00-12:30.

Class Dues: Each year, a student must pay his/her \$6.00 class dues to cover expenses for Homecoming, Prom, and other student activities. A student may pay \$24.00 his/her freshman year to cover all four years of high school. All seniors must pay an additional \$6.00 Graduation fee.

Parking Tag: All students who drive a vehicle to school must complete a parking application and return it with the \$5.00 parking tag fee.
