RESOLUTION 2017-R- 5

A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING CURRENT AND FUTURE SUPPORT FOR MAINTAINING THREE (3) PRE-K THROUGH 12TH GRADE SCHOOL CAMPUSES THROUGH PRIOR ADOPTION OF THE 2017 WEST CLARK SCHOOL BUILDING RENEWAL/RESTORATION, EXPANSION AND SAFETY PROJECT ON JUNE 20, 2017 BY WEST CLARK COMMUNITY SCHOOLS CORPORATION BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES

Comes now the Board of School Trustees (the "Board") of the *West Clark Community Schools Corporation* (the "WCCS"), the governing body of the WCCS, pursuant to IC §20-47-1-5(a), and states as follows:

WHEREAS, The Board of the WCCS has previously adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") which has commenced the referendum process seeking approval to secure bond funding for *the 2017 West Clark School Building Renewal/Restoration, Expansion and Safety Project*; and,

WHEREAS, a part of that Resolution states that WCCS will spend funds derived from sale of bonds at all three (3) existing campuses - at Borden, Henryville, and Silver Creek - if/when a referendum ballot question is voted on and approved by special election on November 7, 2017; and,


WHEREAS, despite repeated public expressions of the Board's intents, described above, certain misinformation to the contrary has been propagated; and,

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to try and remove any doubts about the Board's continuing commitment to follow through with its intentions expressed earlier regarding these matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of School Trustees of the West Clark Community Schools Corporation that the Board hereby expressly and publicly reaffirms the Board's intent and commitment to maintain three (3) separate Pre-Kindergarten through twelfth (12th) grade campuses in the West Clark Community Schools Corporation, one (1) each at Borden, Henryville, and Sellersburg (Silver Creek), at their current locations.


