

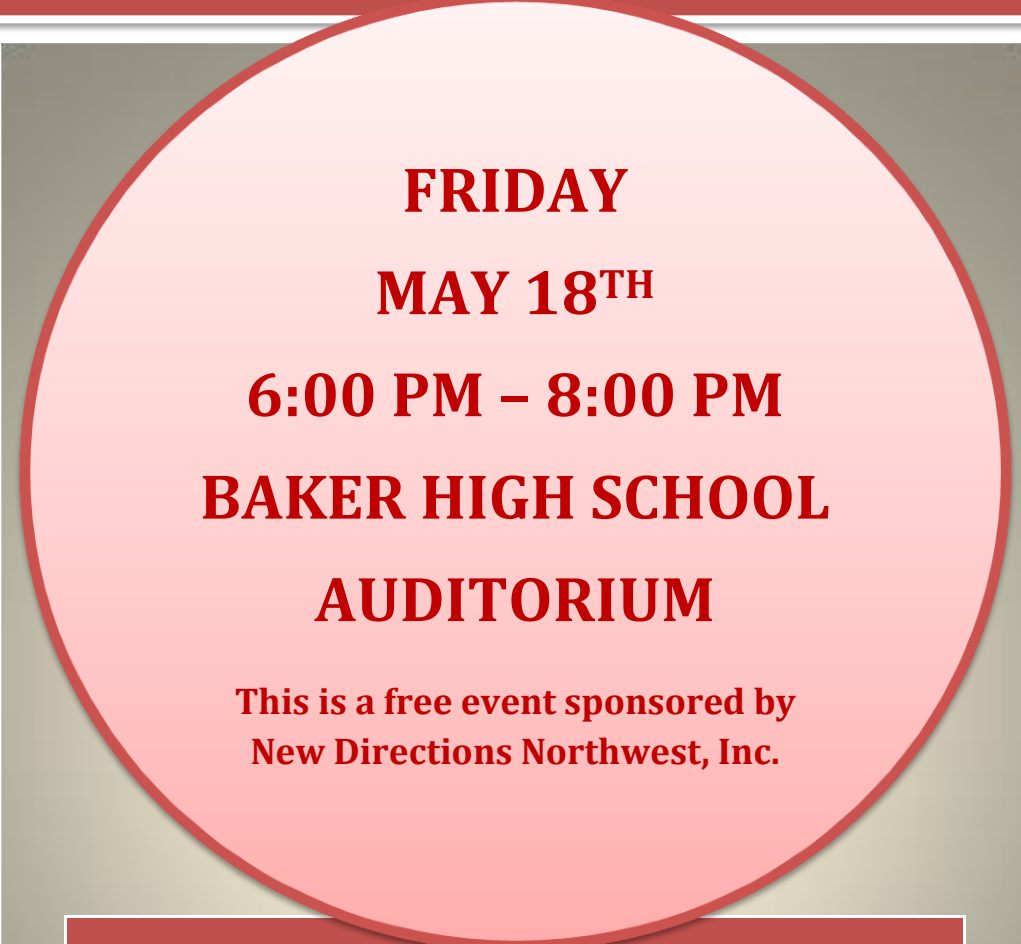
**“IF I COULD HAVE A DO-OVER”

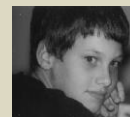
