

RESOLUTION 2017-R-6

A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING BOARD INTENT ON INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS

Comes now the Board of School Trustees (the "Board") of the *West Clark Community Schools Corporation* (the "WCCS"), the governing body of the WCCS, pursuant to IC §20-47-1-5(a), and states as follows:

WHEREAS, The Board of the WCCS has previously adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") which has commenced the referendum process seeking approval to secure bond funding for *the 2017 West Clark School Building Renewal/Restoration, Expansion and Safety Project*; and,


WHEREAS, a part of that Resolution states that WCCS will spend funds derived from sale of bonds at all three (3) existing campuses - at Borden, Henryville, and Silver Creek - if/when a referendum ballot question is voted on and approved by special election on November 7, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to try and remove any doubts about the Board's continuing commitment to follow through with its intentions expressed earlier regarding matters of student transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of School Trustees of the West Clark Community Schools Corporation that the Board hereby expressly and publicly reaffirms the Board's intent and commitment to support voluntary intra-district student transfers, subject to the conditions set out below:


- Voluntary intra-district transfers would begin once new construction is completed to the extent that sufficient classroom space exists to accommodate transfer requests from across the entire district.
- Intra-district transfer students will be given priority over out-of-district transfer students.
- Student capacities for each school will be determined by the School Board and the Superintendent during the month of February preceding the Summer/Fall start of school.
- Intra-District registration will be open from March 1 through May 31 each year.
- Out-of-District transfer application opens June 1 through start of school. If there is not enough space to take all out-of-district transfer students who apply, a lottery will be held by July 15 to determine which out-of-district students will be accepted.
- Grandfathered status: "once in, you are entitled to stay in for rest of educational years"
- No transportation offered to any student who is attending a school outside of the student's regular residence district.
