

Writing:

- *write correctly using a two or three finger grip
- *write name legibly
- *write some upper and lower case letters legibly

Oral Language:

- *express ideas and feelings orally
- *take part in conversations and group discussions by taking turns to talk
- *respond to questions appropriately

Mathematics:

- *name, count, and order numbers 0-10

- *can make a basic pattern with three different colors, shapes or sizes (red, blue, green, red, blue, green, etc...)
- *understand the words: yesterday, today and tomorrow
- *sequence items by size (largest to smallest - tallest to shortest, etc...)

Basic Skills:

- *know phone number, address, birthday and 911
- *can zip, tie, snap and button
- *know first and last name
- *know parents' names
- *can draw a picture of self that include basic body parts
- *use scissors correctly and knows how to cut on a line

Student Drop Off and Pick Up Information

We have many students who attend PRE and we strive to keep ALL students safe. We ask that parents follow the following procedures for student drop off and pick up so that we may keep our students safe. Parents and students need to please use the sidewalks and crosswalks upon entering and leaving the school grounds. Bicycles are to be dismounted when on school grounds. We ask that parents refrain from standing in the hallway to drop off/pick up students. Your attention to this matter will continue to help relieve the congestion in our hallways and confusion for our students.

STUDENT DROP OFF (AM)

- Please drop off your child at the front entrance. Students should exit the vehicle next to the sidewalk at the front entrance. You can also drop off your child on Cinnamon Teal and they can cross at the crosswalks. A teacher will be on duty at the front entrance and crossing guards at the crosswalks on Cinnamon Teal starting at 8:10 AM.
- Students arriving at the front entrance are to go directly to the playground area through the cafeteria where they will meet with their class.
- Please do not leave your car parked in front of the school. Unattended and parked vehicle are PROHIBITED in the drop off and pick up lane before and after school. Please park in designated parking areas in the North visitor parking lot and along Cinnamon Teal Road. The flow lane must remain open for everyone to exit.
- **DO NOT** drop your child off in the **South** parking lot because of the bus traffic.
- Some parents have chosen to drop students off in the North parking lot. If you choose to do this, please make certain you are within the yellow lines and your child exits your vehicle next to the sidewalk. There is no staff member monitoring this drop off location, however, there are teachers nearby monitoring students on the playground.

STUDENT PICK UP/WALKERS (PM)

- All students to be picked up will be waiting at the front of the building. All siblings are to meet at the front entrance.
- All students are to go directly home after school and are not permitted to stay on school grounds at the end of the school day.
- ALL pedestrians need to use the crosswalks in the front of the school and on Cinnamon Teal. Parents, please help us model this for the safety of your children. There is a teacher on duty to help children cross in the front of the school. There are crossing guards at the crosswalks on Cinnamon Teal.
- Once again, please do not leave your car unattended in front of the school and do not block the flow lane. Please instruct your child to find your car so that you may leave as quickly as possible.
- **DO NOT** use the **SOUTH** parking lot to pick up your child because of bus traffic.

The school day begins at 8:30 and ends at 3:30. Students are asked to come to school as close to the starting time as possible. Please be there promptly at the end of the day to pick up your children. We hope that you will continue to adhere to these routines with your child so we can maintain a safe environment.

AM Kindergarten Pick-Up

For the safety of your child, we ask that you please follow these instructions when picking up your AM kindergartner:

-Please be on time. It is scary for children when you are not here to pick them up. If you are running late, please call the office. Before lunch pick-up time is 11:30 and after lunch pick-up is 11:50.

- Please do not come into the school to wait for your child. A staff member will bring the children out front and have them line up against the wall.

-Please exit your car and walk up to the front of the building to collect your child.

-We will not allow the children to walk to a car or walk away from the building without a parent (or other approved person) first walking up to gather them.

-If you are not here to pick up your child and we have not received a phone call from you, we will bring your child back into the office and first call you and then your emergency contacts until we find someone to pick up your child.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are glad your child will be joining us for Kindergarten this fall. Your school nurse will be in your school 1 day per week and a health aide will be present the other days. You are welcome to speak to either of us about any concerns you may have regarding your child's health and care at school.

Your child will need their immunization records and a copy of their latest physical exam. Please note that students entering Kindergarten need booster shots by the time school starts.

If your child will need medication during school hours, you may fill out a medication sheet and bring it to the nurse's office along with the medication needed. We will not give Tylenol, Advil, etc. without this form. A physician signature is needed for all medications.

If your child has a serious allergy, such as bee stings or peanuts, please have your physician complete a severe allergy form and return it to the nurse, along with the medications needed at school i.e. inhalers, Epi-Pens, Benadryl, etc. See the nurse for these forms.

If your child is absent, please call the attendance line at your school prior to the start of each school day.

When should my child stay home from school?

*If your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher. **Children should be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications, such as Tylenol before returning to school.**

*If your child is vomiting or has vomited in the past 12 hours.

*If your child is having diarrhea or has had it in the past 12 hours.

*If your child is being treated for an infection with antibiotics and it has been less than 24 hours.

*If your child is too uncomfortable to learn or participate in learning.
