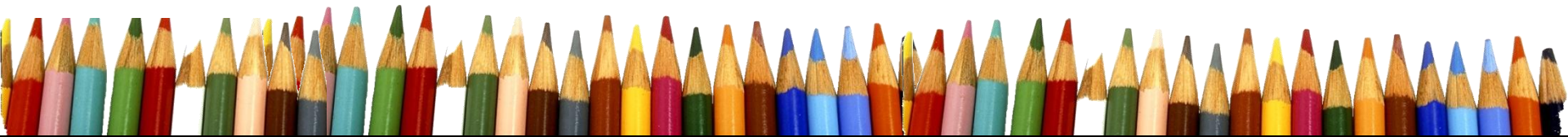

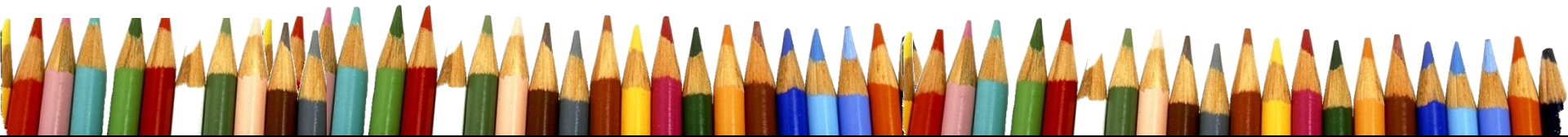

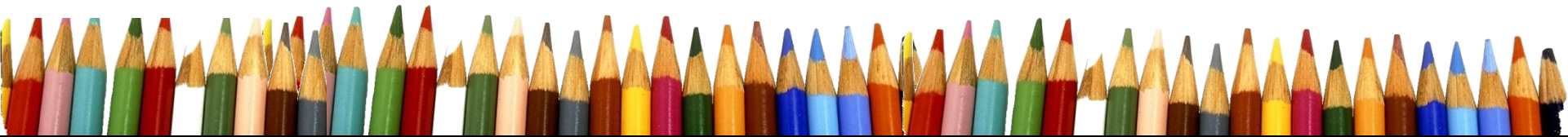


District Rankings: Statewide

(Last year we were number 33 in the top 6.6%)



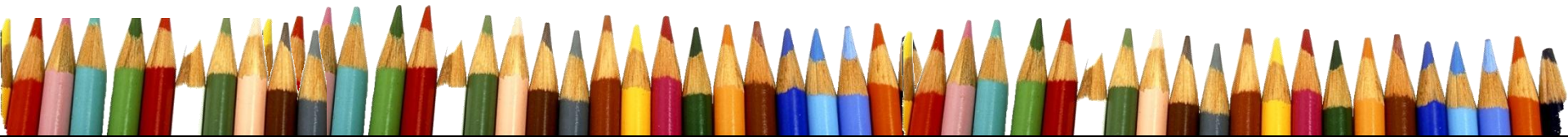

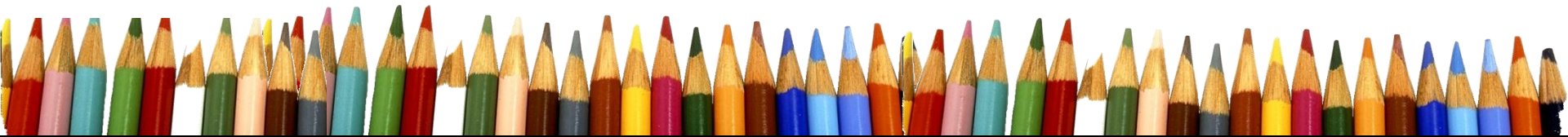

Southwestern PA District Rankings 2010

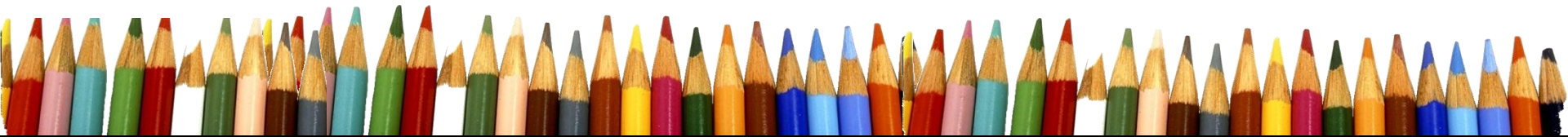

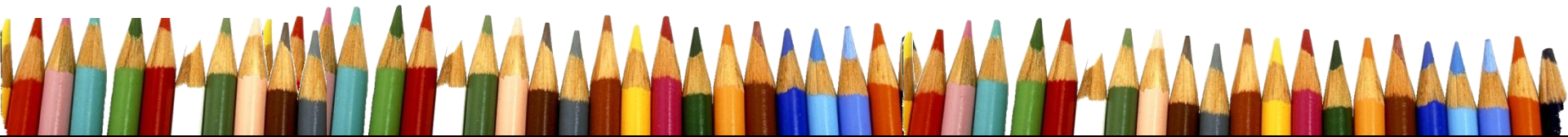
2010 PSSA Highlights: Math and Reading

 - Grade 4 Math (*ED Subgroup*)



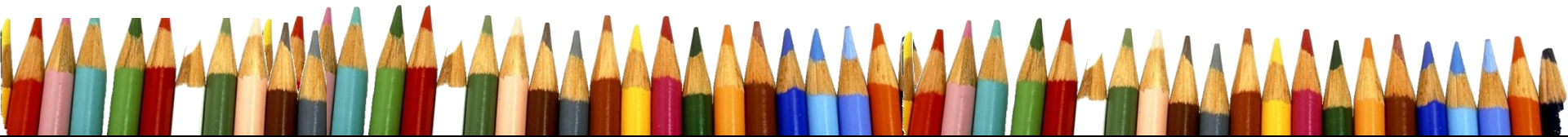
2010 PSSA Highlights: Science and Writing

 - Grade 5 Writing (*IEP Subgroup*)



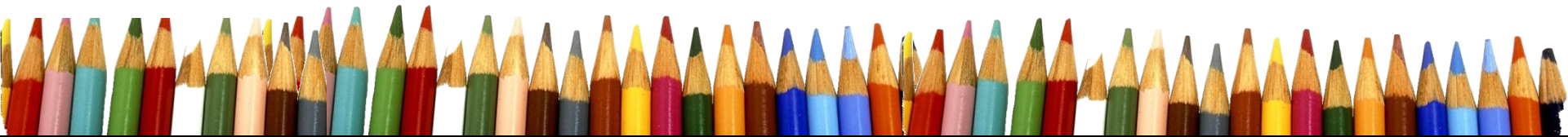
More 2010 PSSA Highlights

 - Ed Subgroup



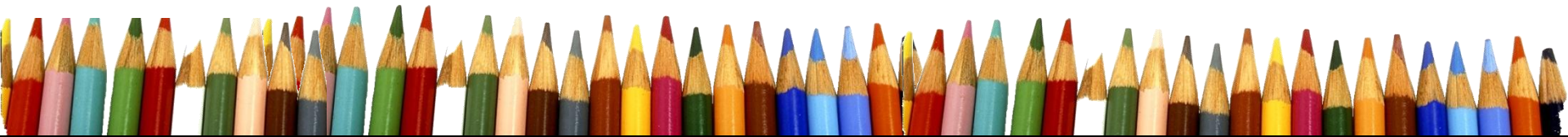
More 2010 PSSA Highlights

- More percentages of students are growing from grade 8 to grade 11 in both math and reading than in past years

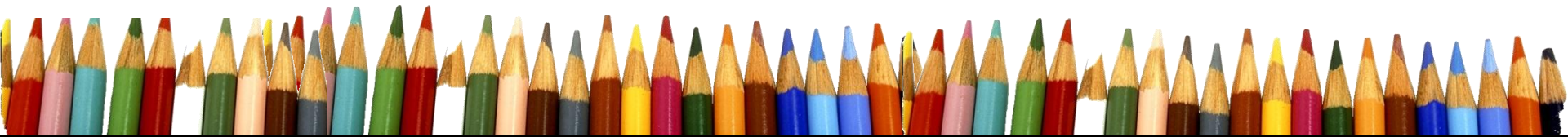


Focus Areas

- Transition from 4th to 5th grade
- IEP subgroup growth across all areas

KEEP IN MIND

- AYP percentages are increasing in 2011
 - Reading from 63% to 72%
 - Math from 56% to 67%
