## Medical Alert: Hepatitis A



Camino Nuevo Families:

Amid the hepatitis A outbreak currently centered in the homeless community, Los Angeles county health officials are urging everyone to take precautions to avoid getting sick. Hepatitis A is a contagious liver disease that is often spread by touching objects or eating food that someone with the virus has handled. Symptoms include vomiting, fever, yellowing of the eyes or skin, joint pain and dark urine. At Camino Nuevo, we are taking all necessary precautions to protect staff and students, including reminding personnel and students not to share food or drinks and to wash their hands with soap after using the bathroom or before handling food. We encourage you to take these safety precautions at home. The best way to prevent infection is by getting a hepatitis A vaccine. Visit your doctor's office, a pharmacy, or call 2-1-1 to find a local clinic or doctor.
