GENERAL MEETING

Meeting called to order at 3:15.

WELCOME

Dr. Narro welcomed the parents and staff for coming to the School Site Council meeting.

BUSINESS

1. Review and approve October 19, 2016 minutes
 - a. Gina Loyonnet made a motion to approve the minutes.
 - b. Rebecca Bertolina second the motion.
2. School Safety Plan
 - a. School Safety Plan was reviewed with SSC.
 - b. SSC reviewed the policies and procedures of suspension and expulsion.
 - c. SSC reviewed the procedures for emergency drills.
 - d. Fire drills are conducted monthly.
 - e. Child abuse reporting was discussed with committee. All staff members (certificated and classified) take an online program at the beginning of the school year.
 - f. School Safety Plan will be presented to to parents in a PTA meeting scheduled 1/17/17.
 - g. Laurie T. made a motion to approve the School Safety Plan.
 - h. Dawn T. second the motion.

1. SPSA Progress Monitoring Update-
 - a. Dr. Narro discussed district assessments. In reading and mathematics, each grade level made a determination on the assessments that are going to be used. In writing, each grade level is using the district writing benchmarks. In 3rd-5th grade, the students are given IABs. CAASPP results determined what IAB assessments were going to be given. Next school year, the assessments might change because we will be adopting a new ELA curriculum.
 - b. In November, teachers have been providing data to Dr. Narro. Dr. Narro will be meeting with teachers in January to discuss students who are receiving 1s in assessments.
 - c. Read Live and Lexia is being used for reading intervention. Teachers have noticed growth in students.

- d. Interventions - first grade teachers identified students who would benefit in reading intervention. Mrs. Reyes our current kinder Spanish teacher meets with our 1st grade students. Students have been exited and new students have been entering Mrs. Reyes' group.
- e. Ms. Zelenski is currently working with 2nd grade students who would benefit from reading intervention. She meets with 2nd grade students 4 days a week before school.
- f. Ms. Moore, Ms. Blum, Ms. Stearn, Ms. Lee, Ms. Detterich, and Ms. Tull use, "Read Live" that builds basic reading comprehension skills, vocabulary and fluency.
- g. "Lexia" is an online program that focuses on reading, comprehension, academic vocabulary, and listening. "Lexia" is offered to students needing support in reading.
- h. Imagine Learning is also an online program that is offered to English Language Learners.
- i. Mrs. Selden asked are there programs for our highly gifted students. GATE students are clustered and instruction is differentiated within the classroom.
