OFFICE

Building 1 houses the administrative and clerical offices of the school. The sign-in/sign-out book for students who arrive late or leave early and the visitor/volunteer sign-in sheets are also located here. All visitors/parents coming onto the school campus must obtain a visitor/volunteer sticker.

COMPUTER LAB

In addition to having computers with Internet access for computer instruction in every classroom, students are scheduled to have a computer lab class once each week. During their computer lab classes, students are taught computer skills such as keyboarding, word processing, researching using the Internet, and other age-appropriate technology.

LIBRARY

Our state-of-the-art library allows each of our student's access to research materials, periodicals, and the best of children's literature. Students in grades PK3 – 2 and 5 – 7 have a designated library time each week; students in grades 3 - 4 visit the library during Reading class. During this time, students are taught age-appropriate research and library skills, as well as having the opportunity to check out books to take home. Middle school students have access to the library for research and checking out books before and after school, and during study hall.

MUSIC ROOM

Students in grades PK3 – 4 have a scheduled music class once per week. In addition to liturgical music, students have instruction in music theory and music appreciation. Students in 3rd grade are taught to play the recorder, and 4th grade students are taught the soprano recorder, both of which act as an introduction to participation in band. Students in grades 2 – 7 may join the choir to sing at the weekly school Mass, Spring concert, and various functions throughout the school year. Also, students are encouraged to audition for the District VI Honor Chorus. The Band, which is open to grades 4 – 7, meets in the Music Room before, after, and during the school day. There are also Early Childhood music classes where the children do developmentally appropriate activities which will enhance all of their skills - social, emotional, physical, and academic.

ASSEMBLY HALL

The Assembly Hall is where our students eat lunch every day. It is also where our Before/After Care students assemble. In addition, other activities, such as Men's Club meetings, Ladies' Co-op meetings, guest speakers, etc., take place in the Assembly Hall.

PARISHIONERS' CENTER

The Parishioners' Center is located at the south center of the church parking lot. This multi-purpose building has been designed to be used by all parishioners. It provides space for numerous parish assemblies and activities. The facility accommodates large gatherings for social and sporting activities, meeting rooms for parish group activities, office space for parish support staff, a kitchen to support parish activities, storage, and other support space. Numerous school activities are held in this building, including school board meetings, scout meetings, sporting events, concerts, dramatic productions, pep rallies, etc.

STUDENT SERVICES

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE

St. Philip Neri School offers quality extended care, both before and after school. Students are monitored before school beginning at 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 A.M. for the cost of \$5.00 per day. After school care begins at 3:30 P.M. until 6:00 P.M. for the cost of \$7.00 per day. There is a \$5 registration fee per school year. Invoices are sent home at the end of each month.

LUNCH PROGRAM

Students may choose to participate in the Archdiocese hot lunch program or provide a bag lunch for their children. Lunch is eaten in the Assembly Hall. Milk is served to those children participating in the hot lunch program and is available for purchase for those students who bring lunch.

P.E.

Students in grades PK3 – 7 have a scheduled P.E. class once each week. Emphasis is placed on exercise and fitness. P.E. uniforms are worn on the scheduled days for students in grades PK3 – 3.. These uniforms may be purchased through the SPN Viking Shop. Students in grades 3 – 7 also participate in a Sports Clinic once each week.

Shoes may be purchased at Schiro's, Ponseti's Children's and School Uniform Shoes, or any store that sells the uniform shoes. Other uniform apparel (P.E. uniforms, mandatory uniform SPN socks, SPN sweatshirts) may be purchased in the Viking Shop, located next to the Computer Lab.

COUNSELOR

The students have the opportunity to meet with our counselor on an at-need basis. In addition, the counselor conducts seminars for students, teachers, and parents on relevant issues.
