### **A Summary of Actions by the Board of Trustees Regular Meeting of May 8, 2012**

The Board of Trustees met on May 8, 2012, at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of holding a regular meeting. Members present were Joe Ruelas - President, Scott Elder - Secretary, David Bullock, Joel Hardeman, Maria Jones, and Mike Tincher. Scott Aaron was absent.

#### **Action Items:**

1. Approved the monthly financial reports, bills, and checks written since the last meeting.
2. Approved the board meeting minutes for April 2, 2012, April 4, 2012, April 5, 2012, and April 10, 2012.
3. Approved Local District Update 93 with the following changes: FFH(LOCAL) and FFI(LOCAL) are to be adopted effective July 1, 2012.
4. Delayed consideration of a contract with New River Fellowship Church. This will be a consideration/action item at the board meeting in June.
5. Approved a trip request for the MWHS Choir as presented.
6. Closed Session Items:
