Child Nutrition Update

Ann Edwards discussed child nutrition within the district. She stated that CBISD received a waiver due to Hurricane Harvey for free meals through the end of October. A waiver for free meals through November will be filed but requirements are changing.

David's Law

Mr. Miller discussed SB 179 that went into effect September 1. Also called David's law, this bill addresses bullying, specifically cyberbullying and the effects on public schools

SB 1566 Lice Notification

Mr. Miller discussed SB 1566 regarding parent notification of students with lice. This law went into effect September 1. Bill specifically states that elementary schools provide written or electronic notification to"

1. Parents of a child with lice no later than 48 hours after school officials become aware.
2. Parents of each child assigned to the same classroom, no later than the fifth school day after school officials become aware.

Discussion on school procedures and a blanket letter that all elementary schools can use.

AED Inventory

Mr. Miller led discussion on AED inventories and needs to remain in compliance. Also discussed adding additional AED for H wing at CHS to service band/dancing dolls and ag students. This might be beneficial due to distance to training room and nurse's station.

Also, consider an AED for new gym at junior high.
