What is a Wellness Network?

Wellness Networks will connect students and families to essential preventive and primary care services, along with a variety of programs, insurance coverage and other school-based opportunities to create a healthy life at school and at home. Wellness Networks in LAUSD are designed and built around a Wellness Center, which is an enhanced version of a school-based health clinic. Wellness Networks serve a school complex and help ensure students attend and succeed in school.

Mental Health Services

Aviva Family and Children's Services has two licensed therapists and two case managers, working at Hollywood High Wellness Center, Monday, Thursday and Friday. These staff provides a wide range of services to students and their families. Therapists can provide focused therapies that can help with:

- Trauma • Depression • Anxiety •
- Behavioral Problems •

Other services available include:

- ⇒ Case management to facilitate linkage to community resources
- ⇒ Crisis intervention
- ⇒ Individual parent support (Bi-lingual)
- ⇒ Screening and Assessment for mental health needs
- ⇒ Skill building for social and emotional health



Health Services

Los Angeles Unified School District, Student Medical Services, in partnership with Kaiser Permanente Los Angeles Medical Center provides Hollywood High School with convenient, free and confidential health and wellness services for students. In the future, we also hope to provide free or low-cost health care services to community members in the Hollywood High School vicinity

- Physical exams
Physical exams for sports
Immunizations
- Cough and cold treatment
- Referrals for dental, vision, and specialty care
- Nutrition counseling
- Behavioral health counseling
- Family planning education and services (Contraceptives, birth control, etc.)
- STD testing and treatment
HIV/AIDS counseling and testing

Through our Wellness Coordinator we also assist in enrolling in the following programs:

- Medi-Cal, Medicare, and Medicare Part D
- Public health insurance programs
- CalFresh (Food Stamps)
