**STUDENT GRADES**

R Student report cards will be mailed to the address on file at the school **on Friday, January 12, 2018** from the Arrow Academy District Office in College Station.

The grading scale for Kindergarten is:

E 1-Advanced Development-indicates student exceeds expectations for mastery of grade level content.

P 2- Developing as Expected-indicates student meets expectations for mastery of grade level content.

O 3- More Development Needed-indicates student does not meet expectations for mastery of grade level content.

The grading scale for 1st Grade – 6th Grade is:

R 90-100 (A) – Student demonstrates consistent and independent comprehension and application of subject matter.

T 80-89 (B) - Student demonstrates frequent comprehension and application of subject matter.

C 70-79 (C) - Student demonstrates adequate comprehension and application of subject matter.

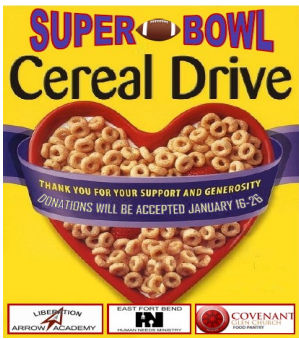
A 69 and Below– Student does not meet grade level expectations.
