Also included on this trip is a very special tour of the Cloisters. At this museum, you will be exposed to medieval art from all around Europe, as well as gain a sense of what it was like to live in a castle. This part of the tour has been specially customized to align with our 7th grade curriculum-no other tour offers this museum!

In addition to the **two** Broadway shows we will see, we will also enjoy dinner at Ellen's Stardust diner. This is an iconic NY location-and most tours do not have the opportunity to experience this. One minute your server will bring you a plate of fries; the next, he will be on stage performing live, perhaps just above your table! Many of the wait staff are currently performing on Broadway in a number of the hit shows. This is not to be missed!

Other notable sites on our itinerary include guided tours of Radio City Music Hall and interviews with the Rockettes, Carnegie Hall, The Apollo, and a walking tour of Harlem Heritage Center.

Of course, we will also see many of the traditional tourist attractions in Philadelphia and New York City. This includes Independence Hall, the Liberty Bell, the Empire State Building, the Statue of Liberty, and the 9/11 Memorial Museum.
