1. The Board and Superintendent will participate in an informational community meeting regarding the Sierra View Modernization Project.

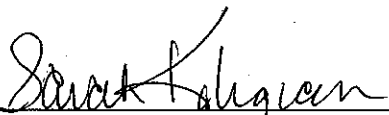
Superintendent Koligian introduces Mr. Doug Reitz of Harris Construction who provided an overview of the project scheduled for the summer of 2011.
