Performance Meter Goal **2016-2017**: For all students to maintain Proficient/Advanced Attendance
Proficient/Advanced Attendance (96% or higher) is maintained by having no more than 1 absence for every 25 days of instruction (maximum of 7 absences in 180 day school year).

- Currently, 56% of students are reaching the attendance goal of 96% or higher. That is a 2% increase from last month.
- Based on the School's End of the Year Magic Number, we need 37 more students to meet our 96% goal.
- 12th grade (72%), followed by 10 (64%), 11th (63%), 9th (62%) has the highest percentage of proficient attendance.
- 9th grade (20%), followed by 10th (18%), 11th (16%), 12th (12%) have the lowest percentage of proficient students.
- Both 9th (1% increase) and 10th (3% increase) grade saw an increase in attendance in the last month.
