

Class Supply List Painting with Watercolor - All Levels 11.1087.xx, 81.1087.xx

- 1. Easel (table top)
- 2. A plywood board (to put watercolor paper on)
- A pad of watercolor paper (140# cold-press 11" x 15" Arches watercolor paper)
- 4. A natural sponge
- 5. A rag or roll of paper towels
- 6. Three or four metal paper clips
- 7. A palette (plastic or metal)
- 8. A soft lead pencil (#2B or #4B)
- 9. An eraser (soft)
- 10.A pencil sharpener
- 11.A liquid drawing gum or frisket (masking fluid)-for special effects in reserving white spaces
- 12. A plastic container (for water)
- 13. Masking Tape
- 14. Brushes: Two round (#0 and #6); Two flat (3/4" and 1/2 ")-one with beveled edge handle for opening up blank spaces; one flat Japanese hake
- 15. Watercolors: (cream in tubes)
