I. Welcome and Introductions

All members were present except Merry Guerra and Mrs. Sermenio

II. Call to Order

Mrs. Rodriguez moved to call the meeting to order at 3:20. Ms. Valdiviez seconded the motion.

- A. **Approval of Minutes** Mrs. Rodriguez motioned to approve the minutes. Olga Briseno seconded the motion.
- B. **Approval of Proposed Agenda** Mrs. Rodriguez motioned for approval of the agenda. Sara Lahr seconded the motion.

III. Committee Reports

- A. **DAC** Merry Guerra was not present. In her place Olga Briseno gave the DAC report since she is the representative for another school. DAC discussed SES tutoring funds and how to utilize them. They also reviewed all of the parent suggestions that were made to the board regarding parent involvement and student technology.
- B. **DELAC** Carmen Chavez reported what took place at the past two DELAC meetings. Parents received a list of educational acronyms. Mrs. Rodriguez will put a copy in the parent section of the school website. DELAC also discussed the SBAC and how to access information online. Members were informed that they will be receiving CELDT scores soon and should review them and talk to teachers if necessary. SSC discussed EL reclassification and that the component that tends to hold most students back is not test scores or language acquisition, but classroom grades. Parents expressed interest in the adult education class that starts this week. Susan Estrada will be teaching it on Mondays and Wednesdays from 5-8. Classes are held at the adult center and are free.

IV. Legal Requirements

- A. **EL Program** New CELDT scores are in. The school and District are looking to see who meets the criteria to be reclassified. Mrs. Rodriguez explained that she has met with students to discuss the

importance of reclassification. Once students have been reclassified they have two years of follow-up meetings. Mrs. Rodriguez has been meeting with our EL students in groups. When EL reclassification changes, SBAC will take the place of CST.

B. Assessment/Curriculum/Program Effectiveness

ERUSD is doing an interim assessment for elementary-high school students in ELA and Math. They are being held through SBAC. It is a practice exam. Results will be placed in EADMS for teachers. –

Based on concerns raised in SSC, 8th grade math honors students will be offered a review class on Tuesdays and Thursday for 1 hour. In addition math clinics will be offered for 6th, 7th and 8th grade students. There will be two teachers in each class. Sessions will be between 1-1.5 hours. It will be a walk-in program that focuses on teaching students to help themselves with their math work. The goal is to teach students to be resourceful and speak for themselves. Mrs. Rodriguez will send home fliers in the next few weeks.
