ELCA students and guest students will be held to a certain standard when it comes to dress code and appearance. Guest students should be aware of the ELCA dress code guidelines concerning piercings and tattoos. Boys are not allowed to wear ear rings, gauges or nose piercings. Girls are only allowed ear piercings. Tattoos must be covered.

Prom dress guidelines are as follows:

- Dresses are to be full length with slits no higher than 4" above the knee
- No cleavage exposed
- No bare midriffs or two piece dresses
- Mesh covering midriff or bust area must have some type of material behind it as to not be "see through"
- Dress may have open back but ribcage should be covered in mesh or dress material
