The Texas Education Agency publishes STAAR® report cards for all students every year. TEA has redesigned the Confidential Student Report (CSR) for results of the 2017 STAAR test. The goal of the redesigned CSR is to create a family-friendly report on student progress, specifically highlighting growth and improvement as much as proficiency. The new CSR features:

- Growth and progress information
- A summer reading list
- Lexile levels and trend data
- New performance level descriptors
- Resources and suggestions for parents to use at home
- Suggested questions for parents to ask teachers and counselors

The new CSRs will be available online and on paper beginning **June 13th for the End-of-Course Exams** and **June 30th for the 3rd -8th grade STAAR test**. To access your students test scores go to www.texasassessment.com and click on the **STUDENT PORTAL**. You will need your child's date-of-birth and their unique access code. The unique access code can be found on any prior CSR or by contacting your child's campus or the District Testing Coordinator
