



# Eagle Activities Eligibility Requirements

Students must have a 2.0 GPA or higher.	Students will have a 2.0 GPA or above to be eligible for all activities.	Student will be on <u>probation</u> for one grading period initially. Student must attend a tutorial daily to remain eligible while on <u>probation</u> & show proof of grades improving. Ineligible Work Back option.
Students must have no more than 1 F.	Students who have no more than 1 F in a grading period are eligible for activities as long as they meet the 2.0 GPA criteria or are on probation.	Student will immediately be considered <b>ineligible</b> even if their GPA is above a 2.0. Student must follow same expectations as a student below a 2.0 to be able to practice. If there is not enough time left in a season for student to become eligible to play, the student cannot participate with the team in any way.	2 or more Fs	One full grading period.	There is no Work Back option for <b>ineligible</b> students.

Student must not be Suspended more than once.	Students who have had no more than one incident of suspension in a semester are eligible for activities.	Students with two or more incidents of suspension will be <b>ineligible</b> for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods regardless of when the last incident happens in the current grading period. <u>One incident</u> suspension students will automatically serve a 10 school day/14 calendar day <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities.	2 or more incidents of Suspension.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period regardless of when the last incident happens in the current grading period.	Work Back only eligible to clear days off the 10-14 day non-privilege period after a suspension. A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling one suspension.
Responsibility Center/ Structured Day Intervention students.	Students may have only 2 incidents of being assigned RC/SDI in a semester. A student who has a combination of incidents of 1 suspension and 1 RC/SDI will still be eligible.	Students who have <b>3</b> incidents of being assigned RC/SDI will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods regardless of when the last incident happens in the current grading period. A combination of 1 incident of suspension and 2 or more incidents of RC/SDI will result in <b>ineligible</b> for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods.	3 incidents of RC/SDI Or 2 incidents of RC/SDI and 1 Suspension	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period regardless of when the last incident happens in the current grading period.	
Classroom Steps	Students who have 3 or less steps in any class are eligible for activities.	Students who reach step 4 in any class will be ineligible.	4 <sup>th</sup> Step in any class.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	
Dress Code Violations.	Students who have three or less dress code violations in a semester are eligible for activities.	Students who have 4 dress code violations or more will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>next</b> grading period.	4 or more incidents of dress code violations.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling one dress code violation.
Phone Violations	Students who have three or less phone violations recorded in the office in a semester are eligible for activities.	Students who have 4 phone use violations recorded in the office or more will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	4 or more incidents of phone violations recorded in office.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling one phone violation.
Unexcused Absences	Students who have 3 or less unexcused absences in a semester are eligible for activities.	Students who have 4 unexcused absences or more will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	4 or more unexcused absences.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling one absence.
Tardies	Students who have 6 or less tardies in a semester are eligible for activities.	Students who have 7 combined tardies or more will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period. Further tardies will result in a Behavior Contract as well as 1 Week of ASD per tardy.	7 or more tardies combined.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling three tardies.
Check In/Check Out	Students on CICO and have missed 1 day of completion or fewer and are scoring at least 80% routinely will be eligible for activities.	Students who have 2 or more days of not completing a CICO form will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities until the end of their CICO cycle, even if cycle is extended due to further instances. Students who fail to complete form over 5 times during a cycle or who are not regularly scoring at 80% or more will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	2+ days of not turning in form. (Work Back)  5+ days not turning in form and/or -80% regular scoring.	( <b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities until the end of their CICO cycle)  ( <b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods.)	
Missed Saturday Schools	Students who have never missed an assigned Saturday School are eligible for activities.	Students who fail to attend Saturday School without prior approval will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period. Students also assigned 1 week of ASD.	1 or more missed Saturday Schools.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods.	A work back plan is defined as four hours of Saturday School or campus/community service equaling one missed Saturday School. Original Saturday School still must be served.
Missed Detention	Students who regularly attend assigned detention are eligible for activities.	Students who fail to attend detention without prior approval will be assigned detention for lunch and after school on the next school day. Failure to attend either of those will result in Saturday School assigned on the next available Saturday. See Saturday School.	See Saturday School expectations.	See Saturday School expectations.	
Class Cuts	Students with 1 or fewer class cuts in a semester will be eligible for activities.	Students who cut class 2 or more times will be <b>ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading period.	2 or more class cuts.	<b>Ineligible</b> from <u>all</u> activities for the <b>remainder of the current and the next full</b> grading periods.	



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<b>Behavioral Expectations</b>		
Students who have one or fewer incidents of suspension in a semester are eligible for activities.		
Students may have only 2 incidents or less of being assigned RC/SDI in a semester.		
Students who have 3 or less steps in any class are eligible for activities.		
Students who have three or less dress code violations in a semester are eligible for activities.		
Students who have three or less phone violations recorded in the office in a semester are eligible for activities.		
Students who have 3 or less unexcused absences in a semester are eligible for activities.		
Students who have 6 or less tardies in a semester are eligible for activities.		
Students on CICO and have missed 1 day of completion or fewer and are scoring at least 80% routinely will be eligible for activities.		
Students who have never missed an assigned Saturday School are eligible for activities.		
Students who regularly attend assigned detention are eligible for activities.		
Students with 1 or fewer class cuts in a semester will be eligible for activities.
