We have had confirmed cases of the flu at school and are seeing increased absenteeism due to flu symptoms. Please remember that your sick child should stay home for at least 24 hours after his or her fever is gone and vomiting has ended. The fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine. The best prevention for the flu, along with an annual flu vaccine, is frequent hand washing and avoiding touching eyes, nose and mouth.

We would love to see you there!

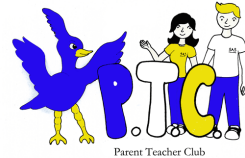
