**Below is the revised Crenshaw County Board Policy concerning excessive absences. This policy becomes effective with the start of the 2018-2019 school year.**

### **Policy 5.40**

#### **3. Excessive Excused Absences**

- 1. A Pre-K student who accumulates six (6) absences or tardies will be contacted by the Pre-K Director to attend an attendance conference.**
- 2. A Pre-K student who accumulates ten (10) absences or tardies will be referred to the OSR First Class Coach.**
- 3. A kindergarten student less than six (6) years of age, who accumulates more than fifteen (15) absences may be withdrawn from the roll for the remainder of the school year.**
- 4. A student in grades K-8 who accumulates ten (10) absences during the school year must attend an attendance committee hearing along with a parent/guardian.**
- 5. A student in grades K-8 who accumulates more than fifteen (15) absences per course during the school year may be denied promotion.**
- 6. A student in grades 9-12 who accumulates five (5) absences in any credit bearing course in any given semester during a school year must attend an attendance committee hearing along with a parent/guardian.**
- 7. A student in grades 9-12 who accumulates more than seven (7) absences in any credit bearing course in any given semester during a school year may be denied credit.**
- 8. A student may be denied a learner's permit and/or a driver's license or have an existing permit/license revoked for excessive unexcused absences.**
