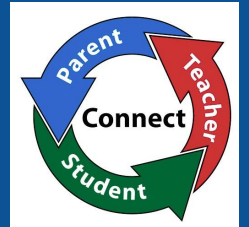




Your Nipomo Schools Present... Parent Education Program at Nipomo High School

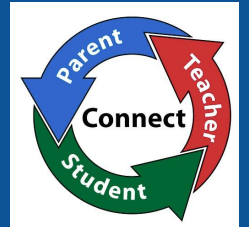
