STUDENT PARKING

I have read the DBHS parking regulations. I understand that I may have my permit confiscated and my vehicle searched if there is reasonable suspicion, drive carelessly, have unmet obligations, drive over the speed limit, park in the faculty/staff lot or anywhere other than a space designated for student parking, or allow unauthorized use of my vehicle. I understand that my vehicle may be towed if I park in a handicapped or visitor space. In addition, if I obstruct traffic or have repeated violations.

Parking permits will go into affect August 20. After that time, students parking on campus without a permit will result in a written warning (Referral). After the second warning, parking privileges will be revoked for 2 weeks. All permits must be displayed upon receipt while on school campus.

Dobyns-Bennett High School Parking Regulations: 2017-18

1. The student parking permit form must be completed with parent and student signature and valid driver's license in hand. In addition, ALL license plate numbers are required to obtain a parking permit.
2. **ALL** students who park a motor vehicle on the school campus must display the current hanging-tag permit. The tag must be hung from the inside rear view mirror, facing the front of the vehicle. Students who fail to display the tag will receive a referral (Written Warning). After the second warning, parking on school campus will be revoked for 2 weeks.
3. The safe operation of vehicles is required. Vehicles must not travel in excess of 10 miles per hour. Seat belts are required for driver and **all** passengers.
4. Supervision is provided for parking lots; however, the school system is not responsible for damages to or theft from vehicles. Students are cautioned **NOT** to leave valuables in their vehicles. Parked vehicles should be left with windows closed and doors locked.
5. Student vehicles are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband is present in the vehicle.
6. Disabled vehicles may not be left on campus overnight. If necessary, towing should be arranged by the student.
7. Only one tag will be issued per student. Students may register up to two of their family vehicles. The tag may be moved from one registered vehicle to another, but may **NOT** be sold or loaned to another student for his or her use. The penalty for so doing is revocation of parking privileges.
8. Inform the activities office immediately of any changes in vehicle or license plate.
9. Lost parking tags will be replaced for a \$5.00 fee. Report losses to the activities office.
10. Loitering in the parking lot is prohibited. Students should lock their cars and leave the parking lot immediately upon arriving to school. Students need written permission from an administrator or SRO to be in the student parking lots during school hours.
11. Parking for individuals with disabilities is available.
12. Students will **not** be issued a parking permit if they have unmet financial obligations.
13. Student parking is limited to the student parking lots: 1) Maroon lot - Front of DB **excluding reserved and visitor spaces**. 2) White lot - The DB side of the Civic Auditorium parking lot **excluding reserved spaces**. 3) Gray lot - Lot parallel to Eastman Road as well as in between the band practice field and Stadium Court. 4) Blue lot - Front of ROTC (opposite side of the Civic Auditorium) as the white lot. D-B only has access to the top 1/3 of this lot and hang-tags are required. **STUDENT PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED during the school day (7:00 AM - 2:55 PM) in the following areas:**
 - Career and technical parking lot
 - Corner of E. Center & Park St. parking lot
 - Fieldhouse - Indian Court parking spaces
 - Faculty and visitor spaces
 - Loading zones/No parking zones and FIRE lanes
 - Sidewalks or lawns
14. Students are expected to park their cars according to the regulations outlined. State and City citations take precedence over DBHS consequences. Examples of DBHS consequences may include:
 - Revocation of parking permit
 - Towing at owner's expense if an unauthorized car is in a prohibited parking area
 - Towing at owner's expense if the parked vehicle obstructs traffic or endangers property
 - Use of stolen, forged, or altered parking passes will result in disciplinary action.
15. Parking a vehicle on school property is a privilege, not a right. Please review all parking regulations with your parents and contact the school if you have further questions.
