

Board Meeting: December 12, 2017:

H.2.c. Recommendation to the Governing Board to Approve New Appointment to the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee

Quick Summary / Abstract:

An election was held in the Moreno Valley Unified School District on November 4, 2014, for the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds of the Moreno Valley Unified School District (the 'District') for various purposes in the maximum amount of \$398,000,000 (the 'Authorization').

The Authorization was received under Proposition 39 which requires that the District establish, populate and empower an independent citizens bond oversight committee (CBOC).

The CBOC consists of at least seven (7) appointed members (per CBOC bylaws Section 5.1) having as its principal purpose the responsibility to inform the public concerning the expenditures of Measure M bond revenues by the District.

Under the Education Code, CBOC members are appointed for an initial two-year term and may serve no more than three (3) consecutive terms (maximum of six [6] consecutive years).

Nine members resigned as of August 1, 2017, leaving those positions vacant. Staff requested authorization to recruit for the nine (9) vacant positions on the CBOC and successfully filled the following positions as of November 14, 2017:

- Alicia Espinoza (At-Large Community Member)
- Ross Nakatani (Senior Citizen Group Representative)
- Cristina Sanchez (Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in the District)
- Adam Sinner (Parent of Guardian of Child Enrolled in the District)
- LaShonda Tillmon (Taxpayer Organization Member)

One position was left vacant and Staff continued recruitment to fill. Applications were received to fill the vacant position. Staff is requesting appointment of the following individual to the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee:

- Jennifer Bell (Parent/Guardian of Child Enrolled in District & Active in any Parent-Teacher Organization such as P.T.A. or a School Site Council)
