Behavioral Health Services

Any student on campus who appears to be experiencing behavioral health challenges may be referred to ATCIC for an intake.

Common reasons could include:

- Traumatic event or history of trauma
- Extended periods of sadness, or depression
- Aggression/violence
- Sudden negative changes in behavior
- Suicidal/homicidal thoughts or statements
- Difficulty adjusting to life stressors
- Isolation
- Poor peer relationships

People's Community Clinic Services

PCC staff provides health and developmental screening, well-child examinations, medical assessment and treatment for chronic and acute conditions, and anticipatory guidance for parents. The department provides a medical home that is accessible, comprehensive, family centered, compassionate, and culturally sensitive.
