Get to class on time

Why is it important?

1. Know everything that's going on in class
2. Feel a part of the class
3. Peaceful relationship with teacher

1. Better prepared for high school
2. Better prepared for university coursework
3. Better prepared for work

What do you need to do?

- Be “on time”
 - That means in your classroom at the bell, with your iPad.
 - If you are at school on time, then you should be in class on time.
 - You will not be responsible for a tardy if it is someone else’s fault, but you must be able to prove it!
 - For PE - lined up for locker rooms

What if I'm tardy?

- The staff will give you a ticket and add your name to a list.
 - If your name is on that list, that means that you will stay after school for 30 min on the next Thursday.
 - You can work your name off the list by asking a teacher, staff or admin to sign it, and they will tell you how to work it off to get the signature.
 - You will have until Wednesday at 4:30 to work it off.

When can I work it off?

- Tickets can only be signed before school, nutrition, lunch or after school. It is NOT allowed to be worked off during class.
- Once it is signed, you have to turn that ticket into Mr. Shahbaz's office. There will be a box.

What if I don't do it?

These are the levels of consequences:

1. 30-minute campus clean up on Thursday
2. 60-minute long campus clean up on Friday
3. 3-hour campus clean up on Saturday

Parents will be called each time you do not complete.
