DRESS CODE INFORMATION

More specific guidelines appropriate for each school may be developed. When a student is clothed in a manner, which is likely to cause disruption or interference with the operation of school, the principal shall take the appropriate action, which may include suspension.

1. Shirts may be collared or uncollared in solid white, navy, black, blue, khaki, or your child's school colors. All shirts must have at least short sleeves. In grades Pre K-5th, shirts may be worn untucked; however, in grades 6th-12th, shirts must be tucked.
 - a. Coats and sweaters must be open down the front.
2. Pants must be the appropriate size and worn at the waist. All pants must be in the colors of navy, black, khaki, or your child's school colors. Jeans without holes, rips, tears, or wording are allowed. If the pants have belt loops, a belt must be worn. Pants and skirts with drawstrings are permitted-provided they otherwise conform to policy.
 - a. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be knee length.
3. Shoes can be any color and sandals can be worn as long as they have a strap in the back. No skate shoes, flip-flops, or house shoes can be worn.
 - a. Shoes must be worn at all times and be appropriate for the activity being performed.
 - b. Shoelaces must be tied.
4. Caps, hats, or head coverings are acceptable for religious customs only.
5. Students shall dress and groom in a clean, neat, and modest manner, so as not to distract or interfere with the operation of the school.
6. Students may wear ear and nose piercing only.
7. Jogging pants and sweats may be allowed by the principal for school purpose determined at the principal's discretion.
8. Principals may permit organizations to wear their uniforms for induction programs.
9. Principals may allow sports team to wear approved uniforms on game days.
