

KHSD GRADUATION AND UC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To aid students and parents in planning, a description of the Kern High School District graduation requirements, University of California, California State University, and Community College admission requirements are included. For those students who wish to enter the world of work immediately after graduation information and assistance is available in the Counseling and Career Center.

Kern High School District Graduation Requirements Class of 2017

Students must earn a total of 220 units to graduate from Ridgeview High School. Passing the CAHSEE and an Algebra class are also required.

English	40 Semester Units (four years)
Math	30 Semester Units (three years)
Science	20 Semester Units (two years) *10 Units in Biology AND 10 Units in Physical Science, Earth, Chemistry or Physics
Social Studies	30 Semester Units (three years)
Fine Arts or Foreign Language	10 Semester Units (one year)
P.E.	20 Semester Units (two years)
Health	5 Semester Units (one semester)
	*RHS students also complete one semester of Computer Applications I to complete a full year of course enrollment
Pathway Requirement	30 or 40 Semester Units
Miscellaneous	25-35 Semester Units

University of California California State University Admission Requirements

Current Admission requirements, frequently referred to as A-G, for the two California University systems are listed below. All courses must be college preparatory.

A. History/Social Studies	2 years required
B. English	4 years required
C. Mathematics	3 years required (4 years recommended)
D. Laboratory Science	2 years required
E. Language Other than English	2 years required (3 years recommended)
F. Visual/Performing Arts Electives	1 year
G. College Preparatory Electives	1 year required
