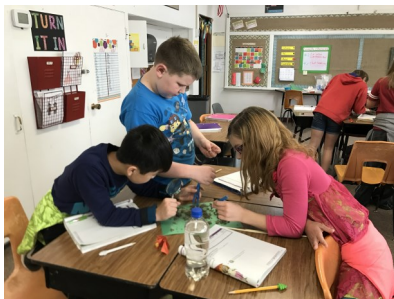
These Lincoln teachers are feeling the holiday spirit for sure.

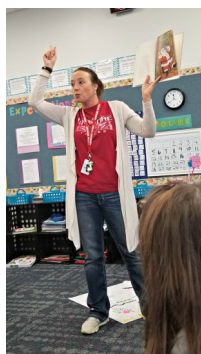
