

**STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL**

**PURPOSE:**

The North Kingstown School Committee thinks it is important for High School Students to have a structured organization to give constructive input to the school administration regarding suggestions, improvements, and discuss issues surrounding the rules and policies of the high school.

**PHILOSOPHY:**

Rhode Island State law mandates the governance of the high school is vested with the principal working through the chain of command to the Superintendent. The School Committee feels it is important for the students attending the high school to have a structured organization such as a student advisory council, for representative students to bring fourth to the high school administration constructive ideas regarding the rules and policies of the high school, and suggestions for improvement.

**POLICY STATEMENT:**

The Principal will decide how election or appointments to the council will be made and the parameters of the organization. The student advisory council will include the Student Member(s) of the School Committee as decided under JIBB.
